After supper Jesus and His followers went to a place called Gethsemane, on the Mount of Olives.







The question is where do you and I stand? Have you accepted Jesus as your Lord and Saviour?





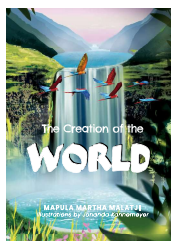
## **Prayer**

Father God, thank You that we do not have to fear death. Thank You that if we believe that Jesus died on the cross to forgive us our sins we will go to heaven.

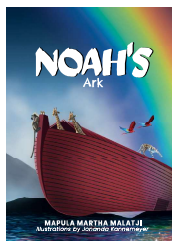

6. What do these stories teach us? Explain your answer.

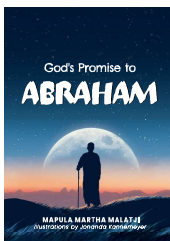
