he traditional celebration of Passover was near, and Jesus asked Peter and John to prepare the big upper room to celebrate their last supper together.


Jesus took bread and broke it. He said, "This is My body broken for you. Do this to remember Me," and He shared the bread with His followers.

Father God, thank You that we do not have to fear death. Thank You that if we believe that Jesus died on the cross to forgive us our sins we will go to heaven.


Questions






