EXODUS 19-20, 24 32 and 34




the first day of the third month after the Israelites left Egypt, they came to a desert called Sinai. They camped there in the desert, in front of Mount Sinai.



No Killing: Never hurt or kill another person.

Be Faithful: Be faithful and true to your husband or wife when you grow up and get married.

No Stealing: Do not take things that don't belong to you.

Tell the Truth: Always tell the truth and do not lie.

Be Happy with What You Have: Do not be jealous of other people's things.

Then Moses went down the mountain with the two tablets in his hands, so he could share them with the Israelites.


King Lion Roars


Prayer

- 5. What happened at the end of the game?


