God saw that the world was filled with wickedness and decided to send a great flood to cleanse the earth.



The Baobab Tree



There are also small benches to rest on. Others stay inside, dancing, praising and singing songs like this:


O, Baobab


Prayer

Dear God, please teach us to respect Your creation and be careful with nature. Thank You for the beautiful earth, plants and trees that You have given to us.


Questions
