We take refuge in your trunk.*

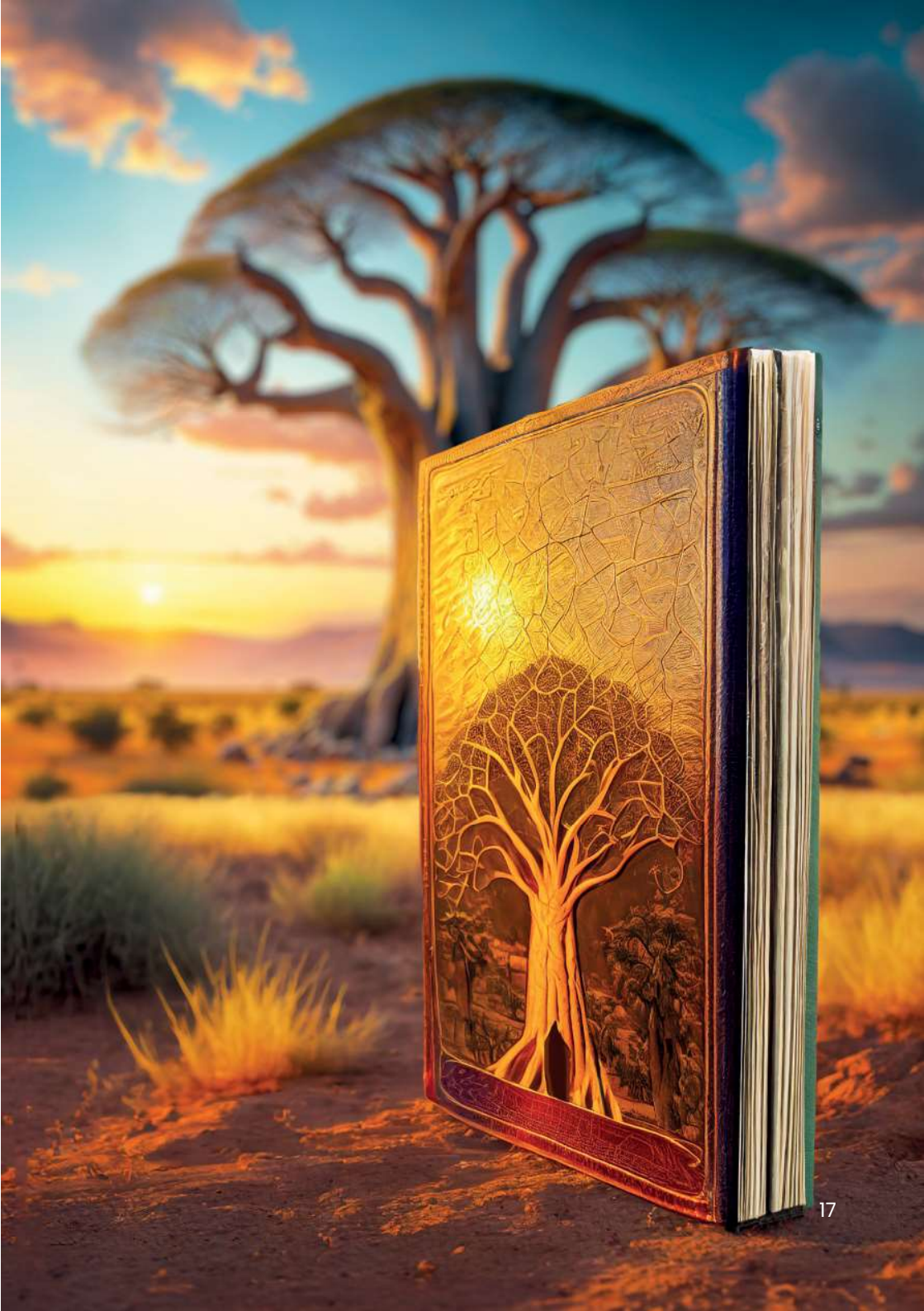


In the same village, there was a man called Korong sitting in his hut near the Baobab tree. He made a window in his hut so he could see the tree clearly, because it was so beautiful.

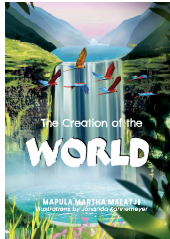
## **Prayer**

Dear God, please teach us to respect Your creation and be careful with nature. Thank You for the beautiful earth, plants and trees that You have given to us.

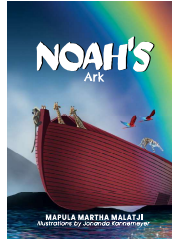
## **Questions**

5. What happened to the people who disliked the tree?

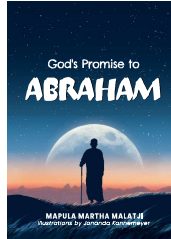
